AVA is particularly interested in providing an academic forum for those working to systematically address different forms of abuse in unique clinical settings, improve teaching in the health professions as well as scientific researchers in the area of violence and abuse.

AVA welcomes proposals for presentations that will foster an interdisciplinary exchange of solutions for the challenges of addressing violence and abuse in the health care setting. Reports of original clinical programs, research related to violence and/or abuse and health or health professional education are particularly welcome. The research may pertain to clinical, economic, health systems, curricular, or faculty development issues in relation to local, national and global efforts to address violence and abuse.

Please note that the deadline for submission is July 1, 2017. Late submissions will not be accepted.

In your submission you will be asked to provide demographic information about the presenter(s). You will then be asked to provide the "Title" of your presentation followed by an "Abstract" of up to 500 words which will include background, methods, results and discussion/conclusion.

Short Papers

Purpose: These presentations should be designed to inform the attendees of new research, concepts, or approaches that advance the understanding and integration of these concepts into the health care system. These will be fifteen minutes long with five minutes for discussion. AVA plans to group the presentations by topic. Several breakout groups will run concurrently. (Presentation 15 minutes, 5 minutes Q&A)

Poster Presentations

Purpose: Poster presentations are an opportunity to display and discuss with interested conference participants your new research, concepts, or approaches that advance the understanding and integration of these concepts into the health care system. (Exposure, 2 hours interactive time)
